CHALET COCHAND is the oldest year 'round resort in the Laurentians, founded in 1916 and operated by the owner.

The Laurentian Mountains are certainly the popular centre of winter sports; Ste. Marguerite, 53 miles north of Montreal, is situated in the snow belt sure of excellent snow conditions during the winter season. Chalet Cochand can be reached over night from New York, Toronto and the Eastern States. From Montreal in two hours. Our sleighs meet all trains.

Chalet Cochand at the crossroads of Laurentian ski trails, is a resort that has everything—a truly Canadian winter resort with the brisk air of the mountains, the deep snow and consistent cold of a northern winter, and skiing facilities equal to any resort in Switzerland. The spacious living rooms, card room, lobby, sun deck and heated solarium all provide a comfortable and homelike atmosphere where one can relax and rest. Cottages are available for parties with the same comfort and service as the hotel. There is a Ski Shop with excellent stock of ski equipment where repairs may be obtained.

Chalet Cochand Ski School will operate as usual under Swiss ski instructors.

The Chalet's thousand acre domain has about 60 miles of well kept trails and is the headquarters of the Laurentian Cross Country Ski Club.

This year Chalet Cochand again presents the Swiss-

type steel cable Ski Tow, 1700 feet long. It is thrilling to relax and experience the sensation of soaring up — up — up — six hundred feet above Lac Lucerne to the Alpine Hut where light lunches and refreshments are served. After a brief rest, there are any number of downhill trails for beginners, or steep and sharp turning schusses for experts. In the immediate vicinity of the Hotel are practice slopes for novice and advanced skiers.

Special attention is given to evening entertainment. Guests can enjoy games, movies, dancing, etc.

Skating, tobogganing, ski joring, or sleigh riding—whatever the sport, Chalet Cochand has splendid facilities and guests will find fullest enjoyment.

Justly famous for its cuisine, Chalet Cochand caters to appetites sharpened by mountain air and exercise—never have you relished meals as you will here—never have you slept as you will in our comfortable rooms. After an invigorating day of skiing, visit our rustic Valhalla Tavern, stocked with the choicest wines and liquors.

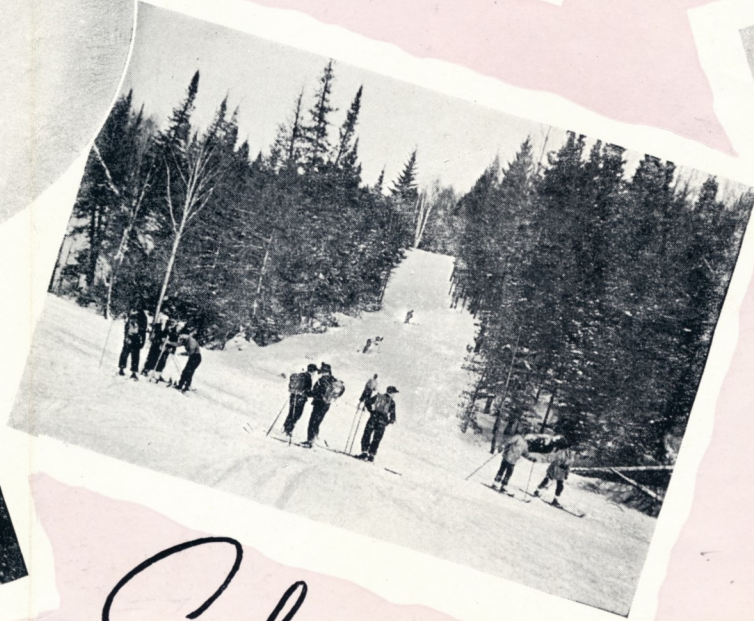
