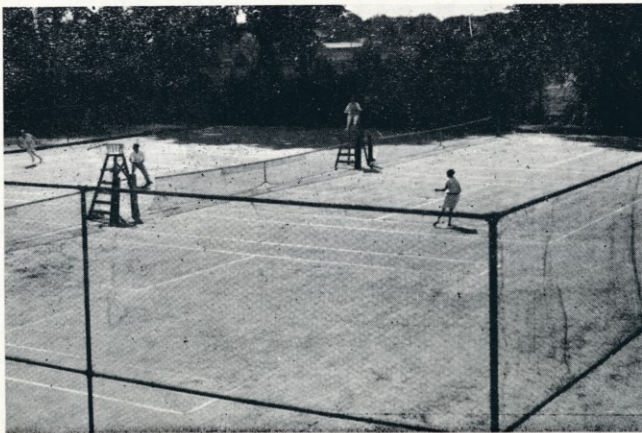
Tennis courts of the finest construction make this sport a favorite at the Laurentide. Right at the water's edge, you just warm up—and then take a plunge.

NO MOSQUITOES, NO BLACK FLIES, NO HAY FEVER

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Laurentian Resort Ready to Greet Hay Fever Guests

American Visitors Said to Find Mountains Favorable Refuge.

STE. AGATHE DES MONTS, Que.,
Aug. 29.—This resort in the heart of
the Laurentian Mountains, is this
month bidding for the attention of
United States visitors seeking haven
from hay fever.

As one of the few spots where rag-
weed, agreed by scientists to be the

cause of hay fever, has not gained
a foothold, Ste. Agathe des Monts,
which has long been famous as a
fishing and hunting territory, is re-
doubling its magnetism.

Its attraction as a resort where hay
fever sufferers can be assured of
immunity from ailment has only
been recently discovered as a result
of a survey conducted under direc-
tion of the Ministry of Agriculture
of Quebec province. During this
investigation of ragweed, which was
made as a preliminary step to a
program designed to prevent spread
of the plant in the province, it was
found that hay fever is non-existent
in Ste. Agathe des Monts.

Vacationists are also directing their
attention to the nearby lakes which
teem with trout. During the hunting
season sportsmen make their head-
quarters here.
